Established in 1981 The Jerusalem Rape Crisis Center was one of the first such centers in the country, aiming to provide a comprehensive response to the suffering of local women subject to the trauma of sexual violence. Offering vital crisis intervention, a supportive ear and practical assistance to women, girls and children who have been raped, abused, harassed or sexually assaulted. Callers to our hotline who express a need for further support can participate in one of the professionally supervised support groups run by the JRCC, which cater for the specific needs of rape victims and incest survivors, as well as tailored programs for people with cognitive disabilities and women with drug and alcohol addiction who have been abuse. We also have groups for parents of victims and at risk populations. The JRCC offers a limited subsidized therapy program for low income callers to the hotline. We also run an education dept and a Victim-Witness Assistance Program. Please call for further details.

The Glickman Center in Tel Aviv serves as a shelter for battered women and their children and a counseling and treatment center for battered women, violent men and children who are exposed to family violence.

OPEN Section: Counseling and guidance for victims of physical and psychological violence. Diagnosis of immediate and future risks. Support groups and treatment for battered women and treatment for children exposed to violence. Legal help and advice is also available.

The Shelter: The Battered Women's Shelter is located in a **Closed off** section of the Glickman Center. It houses Jewish and Arab women, veterans and new immigrants. The secular and traditionally observant escaping from extremely dangerous situations. The professional staff work cooperatively with all community agencies that give assistance and service to the women and their children. The shelter staff includes social workers, a kindergarten teacher, a lawyer, a housemother and a professional counselor for the children. A group of dedicated volunteers work side by side with the shelter staff.
